Her troupe travels to France, encountering an umami cooking competition; a dead whale; an ultra-nationalist named Breivik; unrequited love; Kakuzo robots; red herrings; uranium; an Andalusian matador. Episodic and mesmerizing scenes flash vividly along, and soon they’re all next off to Stockholm. With its intrepid band of companions, *Scattered All Over the Earth* (the first novel of a trilogy) may bring to mind Alice’s *Adventures in Wonderland* or a surreal *Wind in the Willows*, but really is just another sui generis Yoko Tawada masterwork.
